DR A MACMAHON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PLANNING AND MINISTER FOR PUBLIC WORKS (HON M SCANLON)—

QUESTION:

With reference to capital spending on social housing—

Will the Minister advise (a) what were and are the individual capital spending measures and amounts for social housing in financial years 2021-22 to 2024-25, (b) whether these measures include funding provided by the Housing Investment Fund and if so, in what amounts and (c) whether these measures include funding provided by the Federal Government's Social Housing Accelerator Payment, and if so, in what amounts?

ANSWER:

- a) Details of the annual allocation of funding are available in each year's Budget Papers, freely accessible online at <https://www.treasury.qld.gov.au/resources/>. The published Budget Papers show the social housing capital program funding allocated for 2021-22 is \$502.6 million; for 2022-23 is \$441.3; and for 2023-24 is \$741.8 million. The State Budget for 2024-25 will be tabled by the Deputy-Premier and Treasurer, in June 2024, and available online at that time.
- b) These measures do not include funding provided by the Housing Investment Fund.
- c) These measures do not include funding provided by the Federal Government's Social Housing Accelerator.
