

## **Question on Notice**

**DR A MACMAHON** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PLANNING AND MINISTER FOR PUBLIC WORKS (HON M SCANLON)—

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise if the government has figures, either actual or estimated, regarding (a) the number of fully insulated homes in Queensland, (b) the number of partially insulated homes in Queensland, (c) the number of non-insulated homes in Queensland and (d) how many of these are owner-occupied, and how many are subject to a residential tenancy agreement, for each category from (a) to (c)?

**ANSWER:**

The Department of Housing, Local Government, Planning and Public Works (the department) does not monitor the number of fully insulated homes in Queensland.

Information about homes with insulation is reported through a range of publicly available sources including the Australian Bureau of Statistics and advocacy bodies.
