**MRS L GERBER** ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE (HON D FARMER)

### QUESTION:

Will the Minister detail all outsourced service delivery funding to community organisations for Youth Justice (reported separately by year and by organisation) for the last five years?

### ANSWER:

In line with the Queensland Government's commitment to transparency and accountability, the Department of Youth Justice contributes annually to the Queensland Government Investment Portal – Expenditure Data.

The Expenditure Data is available through the Queensland Open Data Portal and is a consolidated dataset that covers a range of grants and procured frontline services across Government, including youth justice, education, sports, arts and environment.

To identify information relevant to funding for Youth Justice, click on the link for the desired financial year and download the file. The data will need filters set for:

- community organisation (heading titled “Legal entity name”, column B, and “Service provider name”, column C)
- correct department (heading titled “Funding agency”, column L)
  - 2022-2023 – DYJESBT
  - 2021-2022 – DCYJMA
  - 2020-2021 – DCYJMA
  - 2019-2020 – DCSYW
  - 2018-2019 – DCSYW
- funding program (heading titled “Program title”, column M).
