MR J LISTER ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (HON S FENTIMAN)—

QUESTION

With reference to the government's Satellite Hospital Program—

Will the Minister provide the number of attendances to the Minor Injury and Accident clinics (reported separately by hour of operation (e.g. 8:00am - 8:59am, 9:00am - 9:59am) and by each operational facility and each calendar month the facility has been operational)?

ANSWER

Our nation-leading Satellite Hospitals have treated more than 40,000 patients in their Minor Injury and Illness Clinics – this includes more than 8,300 in the month of December alone.

As part of our ongoing commitment to making health performance data more transparent and more accessible, the Queensland Hospital Performance website (<https://www.performance.health.qld.gov.au/>) now includes quarterly presentation data about the Satellite Hospitals which have opened.

The information requested in this question represents a significant volume of data that, at this stage, would be an unreasonable diversion of resources.

I am advised that the below table outlines the total presentations at each Satellite Hospital Minor Injury and Illness Clinic since opening, up to and including 28 February 2024.
