**MR M HART** ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS AND MINISTER FOR DIGITAL SERVICES (HON B MELLISH)—

### QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the current total number of vehicles registered in Queensland (reported separately by garage address postcode)?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Burleigh for the question.

I am advised that the collation of the current number of vehicles registered in Queensland, reported separately by garage address postcode, is a resource intensive process that, potentially, would result in hundreds or even thousands of lines of data, diverting Department and Transport and Main Roads (TMR) officers from undertaking their core duties.

However, data is available for the number of registered vehicles across TMR customer service regions as follows:

- Central Region – 592,539
- Northern Region – 662,854
- South East North – 1,655,382
- South East South – 2,275,909
- Southern Region – 870,816
- Interstate – 38,348
- Overseas – 175
- Unknown/other – 3599
- **Total – 6,099,622.**

This location data is provided as at 29 February 2024, and is based on the residential or business address of the registered operator which may differ from the garage address.
