**MR S BENNETT** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND COMMUNITY SAFETY (HON M RYAN)—

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise (a) what the rules, regulations or guidelines are for CCTV in Queensland police stations and (b) is it a workplace health and safety requirement or recommendation?

**ANSWER:**

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that:

- (a) The QPS Building Design Manual contains specifications, requirements and guidelines for Closed-Circuit Camera Television (CCTV) at QPS facilities, including police stations and watchhouses. The use of CCTV at QPS facilities are implemented using a risk-based approach.
- (b) There is no specific health and safety legislation mandating the use of Closed-Circuit Camera Television (CCTV).
