**MR P WEIR** ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE (HON D FARMER)

## QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise from 2015 to 2024 inclusive by year the percentage of students home schooled in the Condamine Electorate?

## ANSWER:

The Department of Education does not collect data on home education registrations by electorate.

Home Education registration data per education region from 2019 onwards is published on the Department of Education website at <u>https://qed.qld.gov.au/publications/reports/</u> <u>statistics/ schooling/students</u>.

Registration data for the Darling Downs South West region, which includes Barambah, Brisbane Valley, Charleville, Chinchilla, Dalby, Gatton/Lockyer, Kingaroy, Miles, Roma, St George, Stanthorpe, Toowoomba and Warwick, is as follows:

- 2019 373 out of 3,411 registrations (10% of total registrations);
- 2020 437 out of 4,297 registrations (10% of total registrations);
- 2021 522 out of 5,008 registrations (10% of total registrations);
- 2022 892 out of 8,461 registrations (10% of total registrations); and
- 2023 1,034 out of 10,048 registrations (10% of total registrations).
