MR A POWELL ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General provide the annual funding, (reported separately by year) for the last three years (or from commencement) for the following specialist domestic and family violence courts (a) Southport, (b) Townsville, (c) Beenleigh, (d) Mount Isa and (e) Cairns?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for his question.

I refer the Member to the previous answer to Question on Notice No. 404 asked on 19 April 2023.

I note the Department of Justice and Attorney-General advised that a breakdown of funding provided by location for each financial year is not available, as the delivery of specialist domestic and family violence courts is supported by a combination of funding allocated to support the operation of Queensland Courts generally as well as additional targeted Government investment.
