MR S O'CONNOR ASKED DEPUTY PREMIER, TREASURER AND MINISTER FOR TRADE AND INVESTMENT (HON C DICK)—

QUESTION:

Will the Treasurer provide the amount of land tax collected from Queensland properties which have a voluntary conservation agreement over them between the State Government and the landholder (e.g. nature refuges, special wildlife reserves, etc.)?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Revenue Office does not have information to identify properties with a voluntary conservation agreement for the purpose of land tax.
