Will the Premier advise the number of Ministerial Vehicles utilised in this term of government by each Minister, showing in table format - the Minister, vehicle model, purchase cost, disposal amount and kilometres at disposal?

ANSWER:

The Department of the Premier and Cabinet (DPC) publishes information about the Ministerial Fleet on a quarterly basis on both the Open Data Portal and DPC's website at https://www.premiers.qld.gov.au/right-to-info/published-info/our-lists.aspx under the heading 'Ministerial Vehicle data'. The last published report was for the period ending 31 December 2023 and data is available on DPC's website back to 2009.
