**Mr M Hart** asked Premier (Hon. S Miles)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise the number of Ministerial Vehicles utilised in this term of government by each Minister, showing in table format - the Minister, vehicle model, purchase cost, disposal amount and kilometres at disposal?

ANSWER:

The Department of the Premier and Cabinet (DPC) publishes information about the Ministerial Fleet on a quarterly basis on both the Open Data Portal and DPC's website at <https://www.premiers.qld.gov.au/right-to-info/published-info/our-lists.aspx> under the heading 'Ministerial Vehicle data'. The last published report was for the period ending 31 December 2023 and data is available on DPC's website back to 2009.

Since the publication of the December 2023 report the following Ministerial Fleet changes have occurred:
