MR T MANDER ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PLANNING AND MINISTER FOR PUBLIC WORKS (HON M SCANLON)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the ‘Homes for Queenslanders’ plan announced by the government on 6 February—

Will the Minister provide (reported separately by program under the initiative for each financial year for 2023-24 to 2026-27) the funding allocation given to the (a) ‘More homes, faster’ initiative, (b) ‘Support Queensland Renters’ initiative, (c) ‘Help for first homeowners’ initiative, (d) ‘Boost social housing’ initiative and (e) ‘Towards ending homelessness’ initiative?

ANSWER

The Miles Labor Government’s *Homes for Queenslanders* plan, backed by \$3.1 billion over five years, is the biggest investment in housing supply and homelessness support services in Queensland’s history.

The total funding for each pillar over the five years of the plan is approximately \$504 million for Build more homes faster, \$166 million for Support Queenslanders, \$30 million for Help for first homeowners, \$1.75 billion for Boost our social housing Big Build and \$526 million for Work towards ending homelessness.

Funding allocations for individual programs and initiatives, including over the forward estimates, will be available in the forthcoming Budget to be delivered by the Deputy Premier, Treasurer and Minister for Trade and Investment on 11 June 2024.
