MR R KATTER ASKED MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE (HON D FARMER)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide the spend per child on direct instruction of education in Queensland (reported separately by electorate and on primary and secondary funding, and excluding any spend on infrastructure, travel and transport, kindy, statutory bodies or depreciation)?

ANSWER:

The Department of Education does not collect the spend per child on direct instruction of education by electorate.

The My School website at www.myschool.edu.au/ provides per student figures by school and suburb, noting that the figures include more than instruction, such as facilities and administration.
