DR M ROBINSON asked the Minister for State Development and Infrastructure, Minister for Industrial Relations and Minister for Racing (HON G GRACE) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Toondah Harbour redevelopment project in Cleveland—
Will the Minister provide total costs to State government departments coordinated under State Development and Infrastructure (reported separately by department) from 2015 to today?

ANSWER:

In February 2016, the Queensland Government (Minister for Economic Development Queensland), Redland City Council, Redland Investment Corporation (RIC) Toondah Pty Ltd (collectively the Owners) entered into a Development Agreement (agreement) with the Walker Group for its proposed \$1.4 billion Toondah Harbour project.

Economic Development Queensland within the Department of State Development and Infrastructure (DSDI) represents the Queensland Government as one of three Owners under the agreement.

Total costs incurred since 2015 by State government departments only are:

- DSDI – \$1,353,417, and
- Department of Environment, Science and Innovation – \$2,565.
