**MR T NICHOLLS** ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

### QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General provide the vacancy rate of the Office of Liquor and Gaming (reported separately by division and by year) for the last three years?

### ANSWER:

I thank the Honourable Member for Clayfield for the question. I am advised that vacancy rates are a point in time measure that vary over time due to a range of factors. The vacancy rate by division as at 30 June over the past three years, and the most recent available figures are provided below:

Compliance	13.83%	13.66%	9.63%	3.36%
Licensing	4.58%	3.69%	0.40%	-1.36%
