MR A PERRETT ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (HON S FENTIMAN)—

QUESTION

With reference to Ministerial advice that the Queensland Government 2023-24 State Budget committed funding to complete a business case for the Gympie Hospital redevelopment including master planning and concept design—

Will the Minister advise (a) if it has been completed, and if so, when will it be released and (b) if not, when will it be completed?

ANSWER

The 2023-24 State Budget committed \$2.3 million over the next two years to complete a business case for the Gympie Hospital redevelopment including master planning and concept design for the campus.

I am advised the Gympie Hospital Master Planning activities are currently in progress with the Master Plan for the site due for completion in the last quarter of 2024.

The Master Planning activities encompasses various site analyses, including service planning, infrastructure and engineering assessments, and condition assessments. During the Master Planning phase, consultation is undertaken with key stakeholders for the identification and analysis of information required to inform options for the future-state Master Plan.

I am advised the business case and concept design activities for Gympie Hospital will be developed concurrently, with due consideration given to the options provided within the Gympie Hospital Master Plan.
