MR J BLEIJIE asked the Minister for State Development and Infrastructure, Minister for Industrial Relations and Minister for Racing (HON G GRACE) –

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise how many of the department's staff will be travelling to France during 2024, reported separately by (a) before the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games, (b) during the Games and (c) after the Games?

ANSWER:

The International Olympic Committee (IOC), through the Brisbane 2032 Organising Committee, has offered the Brisbane 2032 Games Delivery Partners, including the Queensland Government, the opportunity to participate in the official Observer Program and the Paralympic Future OCOG Activities and Learning (FOAL) Program during the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games. The Queensland Government has been allocated a small number of places to participate in the programs.

Approval has been given for two senior officers in the Department of State Development and Infrastructure (DSDI) to attend the Olympic Observer Program during the Paris 2024 Olympic Games, and one senior officer in DSDI to attend the FOAL Program during the Paris 2024 Paralympic Games.
