MR S ANDREW ASKED DEPUTY PREMIER, TREASURER AND MINISTER FOR TRADE AND INVESTMENT (HON C DICK)—

QUESTION:

Will the Treasurer advise since 2020, (a) the number of separate Supreme or High Court cases the Queensland Government has been involved in, (b) the number of times that costs orders have been awarded against the government, (c) the total amount of these costs orders and (d) the total amount expended by the government on bringing or defending these court cases, including court fees, legal service fees, external legal counsel and third party expert fees, as well as any other associated expenses, e.g. travel and accommodation?

ANSWER:

The matter raised falls within the portfolio responsibilities of the Honourable Yvette D'Ath MP, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister for the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence.
