QUESTION

With reference to the Seniors Strategy that was due for release in 2023, (refer to Questions on Notice No. 666 and No. 920 of 2022)—

Will the Minister advise when the Seniors Strategy will be finalised?

ANSWER

As committed to in the 2022 *Future Directions for an Age-Friendly Queensland*, consultation has been undertaken with over 16,000 seniors via Seniors Expos, Seniors Savings Pop-up events, focus groups and surveys, enabling key priorities to inform a new seniors strategy.

Consultation with older Queenslanders has occurred in diverse settings and locations across the state, and key issues identified are the cost of living and staying in their own homes.

A new seniors strategy is under development for consideration by government.
