MR A POWELL ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General advise (a) if the review of the QCAT Act has been completed and (b) if so, when will the findings be published?

ANSWER:

I note the Member's keen interest in the Queensland justice system, including the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal.

I am advised by the Department of Justice and Attorney-General that work is continuing on the review of the *Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 2009* (QCAT Act) and under section 240 (3) of the QCAT Act, the review will be tabled in the Legislative Assembly of the Queensland Parliament as soon as practicable after the review is completed.
