**MR J KRAUSE** asked the Minister for State Development and Infrastructure, Minister for Industrial Relations and Minister for Racing (HON G GRACE) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Jobs Fund—

Will the Minister advise (a) the total amount of funding available over the life of the program, (b) the total amount spent as at 30 June 2024 and (c) the total allocated expenditure to date for 2023-24 to 2027-28 (reported separately by financial year)?

ANSWER:

As the Minister for State Development and Infrastructure, Minister for Industrial Relations and Minister for Racing I am responsible for the Industry Partnership Program, the Queensland Recycling Modernisation Fund, the Hydrogen Industry Development Fund and the Building Acceleration Fund within the Queensland Jobs Fund.

The total amount of funding available over the life of these funds is \$558.123 million.

The total amount spent of these funds as of 30 June 2024 is \$122.332 million.

The total allocated expenditure for these funds between 2023-24 and 2027-28 per financial year is:

- 2023-24: \$38.572 million
- 2024-25: \$145.045 million
- 2025-26: \$146.126 million
- 2026-27: \$98.386 million
- 2027-28: \$46.202 million.
