**MS R BATES** ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH, MENTAL HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES AND MINISTER FOR WOMEN (HON S FENTIMAN)—

### QUESTION

With reference to patients waiting for an initial service event in a Specialist Outpatient Clinic—

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by each Hospital and Health Service) as at 1 January 2024 (a) the total number of patients waiting for an initial service event in a Specialist Outpatient Clinic and (b) the number of patients who have not been seen within the clinically recommended time waiting for an initial service event in a Specialist Outpatient Clinic?

#### **ANSWER**

Queensland's health system, like health systems across the world, is experiencing a range of pressures, including a global workforce shortage and rapid population growth leading to increased demand.

Demand for specialist outpatient appointments in the 2024 financial year to date has increased by 8.8 per cent compared to the prior year, with almost 373,000 referrals received so far this financial year.

But service delivery is also increasing, with 358,946 initial service events delivered in the financial year to date, an increase of 33,714 (10.4 per cent) on the previous financial year.

In addition, across the state, the number of people waiting longer than clinically recommended has reduced by more than 5,500 (4.4 per cent) since wait lists peaked post-COVID on 1 February 2023.

I am advised that the list below outlines the total number of patients waiting for an initial service event at a specialist outpatient clinic, the number of patients who have not been seen within the clinically recommended timeframes (long waits), the number of referrals received, and the number of referrals treated by each HHS.
