### QUESTION:

With reference to the Department of Employment, Small Business and Training Annual Training Infrastructure Program—

Will the Minister advise the allocation of funds from the \$41,417,000 aggregate amount (reported separately by location, project and amount)?

## ANSWER:

The Miles Government is committed to supporting Queensland's high-quality network of publicly owned TAFE campuses. It's a priority of this government to ensure that these campuses are maintained so that state-of-the-art training can continue to be delivered by our excellent TAFE teachers. Since TAFE campuses were transferred back to the State following the commencement of the *Queensland Training Assets Management Authority Repeal Act 2015*, management of these campuses has been the responsibility of the State and there have been no plans to force TAFE Queensland to pay rent to an asset management authority or any other entity to continue to deliver outstanding training to Queenslanders from these campuses.

With respect to the allocation of funds from the \$41,417,000 aggregate, I am advised that it is not possible to provide the detail the Member is seeking at this time, as all costings have not been finalised.
