DR A MACMAHON ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PLANNING AND MINISTER FOR PUBLIC WORKS (HON M SCANLON)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by type (emergency, long-term etc.)), how many additional dwellings were delivered (are expected to be delivered) as a result of housing and homelessness services capital grants and spending on the acquisition of existing properties in 2023-24?

ANSWER:

The Member's question refers to a number of different programs and includes terms and categories not used by the Department of Housing, Local Government, Planning and Public Works.

QuickStarts Qld (QSQ) is a capital investment program to accelerate the delivery of social housing across Queensland. This construction program will be delivered in partnership with Registered Community Housing Providers (RCHPs) and their partner organisations, through the provision of capital grants, as well as via State-delivered capital build projects.

QSQ will support the commencements of 3,265 social housing dwellings by 30 June 2025.

The Housing Investment Fund supports proponents including RCHPs to deliver social and affordable housing to own and operate over the long term with a target of 5,600 social and affordable home commencements by 30 June 2027.

Additional funding has also been provided under the Miles Government's *Homes for Queenslanders* plan.
