MR T NICHOLLS ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE AND MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

QUESTION:

With reference to the announcement at the 2024 Community Safety and Legal Affairs Committee's Estimates hearing of a working group to investigate the establishment of a police integrity unit—

Will the Attorney-General provide (a) the membership of this group and (b) whether there have been any meetings to date?

ANSWER:

In relation to the Member's question, I can advise:

- (a) The police integrity unit working group is chaired by the Public Sector Commissioner, Mr David Mackie, and consists of representatives from the Public Sector Commission (in addition to the Chair); Crime and Corruption Commission; Queensland Police Service; Queensland Police Union of Employees; Queensland Police Commissioned Officers Union; and Department of Justice and Attorney-General.
- (b) The first meeting of the police integrity unit working group occurred on 12 September 2024.
