**MRS D FRECKLINGTON** ASKED MINISTER FOR ENERGY AND CLEAN ECONOMY JOBS (HON M DE BRENNI)

With reference to the Brady report into the explosion at Callide C3, commissioned on 11 June 2021—

Will the Minister (a) outline what the initial timeframe was for the report to be completed, (b) outline any changes to the timeframe which had been agreed upon, and if so, what and when and (c) confirm whether any interim report has been received?

**ANSWER**

- a) Dr Brady's investigation into the cause of the incident on Unit C4 at CS Energy's Callide Power Station has a broad scope and includes assessment of both technical and organisational factors that could have contributed to the C4 incident. CS Energy did not seek to constrain the investigation with timeframes in the interests of allowing Dr Brady to complete the task thoroughly.
- b) As this is a highly complex investigation, Dr Brady has been given the authority to expand its scope as his work progressed.

Dr Brady is in the final stages of the report. There is no timeframe set for the final report.

- (c) There have not been any interim reports received.
