MR R STEVENS ASKED DEPUTY PREMIER, TREASURER AND MINISTER FOR TRADE AND INVESTMENT (HON C DICK)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the intended capital funding for the Gympie Road Bypass voluntary land acquisitions outlined on page 82 of the Budget 2024-25 Capital Statement—

Will the Deputy Premier advise how many parcels of land will the state need to acquire?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government has committed an additional \$318 million to undertake pre-construction works for a new Gympie Road Bypass Tunnel, which is expected to reduce congestion in north Brisbane.

North Brisbane Infrastructure - a wholly owned subsidiary of Queensland Investment Corporation - will continue to oversee the project over the next stage.

The land acquisitions funded in the Capital Statement are voluntary and accordingly the number of parcels of land cannot be determined at this time, as it depends on voluntary vendor take-up. Further details regarding impacts on property will be determined in the next phase of project design and investigations.
