MR T NICHOLLS ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE, MINISTER FOR PREVENTION OF DOMESTIC AND FAMILY VIOLENCE (HON Y D'ATH)

QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General advise (a) if the super round of the Gambling Community Benefit Fund has been abolished, (b) if so, whether there will be any other opportunity for community clubs and organisations to apply for grants larger than \$35,000 under this fund and (c) if the super round is proceeding in 2024, what quarter of the year this is scheduled for?

ANSWER:

This year, the Gambling Community Benefit Fund will commemorate its 30th anniversary with a \$30 million Super Round with grants available up to \$100,000 to assist community organisations.

The Super Round opened on 18 March 2024 and will close on 30 April 2024.
