QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the total number of police call-outs to all Queensland schools for the 2023 calendar year, with a breakdown of all categories of reports and/or criminal incidents that police were called to respond to?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that a manual examination of individual records would be required to obtain data on the total number of call-outs to all Queensland schools, broken down by reports and/or criminal incidents. I am further advised by the QPS that this is considered by the QPS to be an unjustifiable use of police resources at this time.
