MR D JANETZKI asked the Minister for State Development and Infrastructure, Minister for Industrial Relations and Minister for Racing (HON G GRACE) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Resources Community Infrastructure Fund—Will the Minister advise (reported separately by financial year) (a) what the budgeted amount is each year from 2024-25 to 2027-28 and (b) what amounts have been allocated?

ANSWER:

Since 2019 the Queensland Government has administered the \$220 million Resources Community Infrastructure Fund through three funding rounds delivering community infrastructure for resource communities.

Rounds one and two were a voluntary partnership between the Queensland Government and the resources industry, with the Queensland Government contributing \$30 million and participating mineral resource industry parties contributing \$70 million.

The Queensland Government fully funded a further \$120 million under round three. This round focused on Queensland's coal-producing regions of the Isaac, Central Highlands, Banana, Western Downs and Whitsunday local government areas.
