With reference to the deviated coal seam gas wells being drilled directly under the Condamine River near Dalby which is part of the Murray-Darling Basin and a major recharge zone for the Condamine Alluvium—

Will the Minister advise if appropriate baselines have been obtained, in the subject river locations, in order to avoid any doubt as to the cause of any potential future impacts, these baselines would include (a) water quality, (b) riverine ecology, (c) topography and (d) groundwater monitoring bores in the vicinity of the riverine drilled locations?
