MS W BOURNE ASKED THE MINISTER FOR SPORT AND RACING AND MINISTER FOR THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES (HON T MANDER) —

QUESTION:

With reference to media around gearing up for a sporting revolution with the Games On! Program—

Will the Minister advise, given the Rosewood Crusaders Complex in Thagoona hosts hundreds of players and spectators at the grand finals, when is the next round of appropriate funding that this sporting group could apply for to get funding to upgrade vital infrastructure?

ANSWER:

The Department of Sport, Racing and Olympic and Paralympic Games is currently developing Queensland's new Sport Strategy (Strategy) which will help shape the state's sporting landscape for the next 10 years.

The \$250 million Games On! program will be a key initiative under the Strategy. This initiative aims to deliver new or upgraded fields, courts, clubhouses, change rooms, and lighting across Queensland in preparation for the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games.

The Strategy is scheduled for release later this year and will provide the framework for future priorities, programs and investments in the active industry.
