Hon. G Butcher asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise whether any Members of Parliament who are not Ministers attended any ‘practice’, or ‘mock’ Estimates Hearing sessions or meetings regarding the 2025 Estimates process with (a) the Premier, (b) staff within the Office of the Premier and Minister for Veterans, (c) public servants within the Department of Premier and Cabinet and (d) any Minister?

ANSWER:

The Premier’s meetings with departmental staff and Members of Parliament are publicly available in the Premier’s monthly diary disclosures.

How other Ministers prepared for estimates is a matter for them. I understand that the practice of mock estimates hearings is a longstanding practice, including under the former government.
