Ms J Bush asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

With reference to Answer to Question on Notice No. 756 of 2025—

Will the Premier advise, for the construction phase only of the Olympic Stadium at Victoria Park in the lead up to 2032, any analysis, modelling and risk assessments associated with respect to police and emergency services access to the Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital (excluding any analysis or assessments for actual events to be held at the stadium or during the 2032 Brisbane and Olympic and Paralympic Games)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Department of State Development, Infrastructure and Planning as follows.

The Games Independent Infrastructure and Coordination Authority (GIICA) adopted an evidence-based, data-driven approach to completing the 100 Day Review, which included engagement with subject matter experts including the Department of Transport and Main Roads, Queensland Police Service and Metro North Hospital and Health Service.

GIICA is now in the planning phase for the Brisbane Stadium and will continue to work closely with police and emergency services, along with Queensland Health, throughout the construction phase of the venue development.
