Question on Notice No. 1037 Asked on 16 September 2025

Mr T Smith asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise (reported separately by department, in a table) as at 1 November 2024 and 1 July 2025 (or closest reportable dates) the number of (a) permanent public sector employees (headcount), (b) temporary public sector employees (headcount), (c) contract public sector employees (headcount), (d) casual public sector employees (headcount) and (e) public sector employee vacancies (positions)?

ANSWER:

From June 2024, Queensland public sector workforce statistics are published in the annual State of the sector report. This includes a breakdown of appointment type, as well as employees per department.

I am advised by the Public Sector Commission (PSC) that data for March 2024 and March 2025 is publicly available in the 2025 State of the Sector report: https://www.forgov.qld.gov.au/ data/assets/pdf_file/0031/598171/state-of-the-sector-report-2025.pdf. I note the report outlines an overall increase in public sector full-time equivalent (FTE) employees of 4.99 per cent or 12,871.58 FTE between March 2024 and March 2025.
