MS J BUSH ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the 100-day review and the associated Queensland Police Service restructure—

Will the Minister advise the proposed highest ranking police officer below the Commissioner, overseeing Domestic and Family Violence across the QPS?

ANSWER:

One of the primary objectives of the Queensland Police Service 100-Day Review, was to improve organisational efficiency through enhanced leadership, knowledge management and governance structures.

This has necessarily included proposed changes to the QPS organisational structure.

I am advised that the proposed new structure for the QPS will see critical strategic policy functions, including domestic and family violence policy, consolidated and elevated within a new Office of the Commissioner portfolio.

I am advised that consideration of the final QPS structure is still in progress.
