MS C MCMILLAN asked the Minister for Families, Seniors and Disability Services and Minister for Child Safety and the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence (HON A CAMM)—

QUESTION

With reference to the election commitment in the LNP's 'The Right Plan for Queensland's Future' to provide emergency accommodation for vulnerable women and children through ten new and replaced domestic and family violence shelters—

Will the Minister advise (a) what capital funding has been allocated for these ten shelters, (b) what operational funding has been allocated for these shelters in the 2025–26 Queensland Budget, (c) how many of the ten shelters will be new shelters and how many will be replacements, (d) where will each new or replaced shelter be located and (e) if this information is not yet available, in what year and month does the Queensland Government expect to be able to confirm the number and location of the new and replaced shelters?

ANSWER

Management of the Queensland Government Election Commitment 'provide emergency accommodation for vulnerable women and children through ten new and replaced domestic and family violence shelters' falls within the portfolio responsibilities of the Honourable Sam O'Connor MP, Minister for Housing and Public Works and Minister for Youth.
