MRS M NIGHTINGALE ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Department of Transport and Main Roads Climate Change Strategy—

Will the Minister advise (a) whether the Strategy is continuing to be developed under the Crisafulli Government, (b) the current status and expected timeframe for completion and release of the Strategy and (c) the total amount of funding allocated in the 2025–26 Queensland Budget to support development and implementation of the Strategy?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

I am advised that under the former Labor Government, the Department of Transport and Main Roads approved the development of a Climate Change Strategy in 2022. However, work on the strategy was suspended in March 2024. Should the Member want further information on why this occurred, I would urge the Member to consult the Member's colleague, the former Minister for Transport and Main Roads and Minister for Digital Services.

The Crisafulli Government is committed to net zero emissions by 2050. To meet this objective, a series of practical, measurable steps are being set out by the responsible ministers.

I will continue to work with the Treasurer and Minister for Energy, who is leading the government response in relation to this issue.
