MS W BOURNE ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND THE ARTS (HON J LANGBROEK)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the School and Education Boost funding—

Will the Minister advise (a) a list of schools to receive upgrades under this Fund (reported separately by school, project description and project amount), (b) a list of Business Cases to be funded under this Fund (reported separately by Business Case and amount) and (c) any services to be supported under this fund, reported separately by provider/service and amount?
