QUESTION:

With reference to the department's funding allocation for crocodile management programs—

Will the Minister outline if there has been (a) any decrease in funding over the next three years for education and awareness publications and materials and (b) any decrease in staffing in the crocodile management team?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government will always put human safety first, which is why I am working with my department to update the Queensland Crocodile Management Plan to ensure it is fit for purpose and meets the expectations of regional communities.
