HON L ENOCH ASKED THE MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND WOMEN'S ECONOMIC SECURITY, MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS, AND MINISTER FOR MULTICULTURALISM (HON F SIMPSON)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland's obligations under the National Agreement on Closing the Gap (2020), which commits all governments to implement for Priority Reforms—

Will the Minister advise (a) which specific actions, commitments, or mechanisms required of Queensland under each of these Priority Reforms are no longer being implemented or are no longer proceeding under the Crisafulli Government, (b) whether Queensland has discontinued work to establish an independent Indigenous affairs accountability or monitoring mechanism and (c) if any actions under the National Agreement have been ceased, delayed or replaced by the Crisafulli Government, the date and rational for each change?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government continues to be a party to the National Agreement on Closing the Gap and working with the Joint Council to provide tangible outcomes for the Aboriginal peoples and Torres Strait Islander peoples across Queensland and this work is continuing.
