**HON L LINARD** ASKED MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND TOURISM AND MINISTER FOR SCIENCE AND INNOVATION (HON A POWELL)—

### QUESTION:

With reference to the proposed Springbrook Cableway—

Will the Minister advise (a) what consultation has been conducted with local communities, Traditional Owners, and environmental experts on this proposed project, (b) how will the government ensure that world heritage values are not compromised and (c) what assessment has been undertaken of the fire and climate change risks associated with the proposed project?

### ANSWER:

*Destination 2045: Delivering Queensland's Tourism Future* is a landmark 20-year plan to supercharge our tourism industry. The Crisafulli Government wants to double the value of visitor expenditure to the State's economy to \$84 billion by 2045, make Queensland Australia's number one tourist destination, and deliver lasting benefits to all corners of our State.

As part of *Destination 2045*, Queensland has set its sights on becoming the world's leading ecotourism destination – one that responsibly balances nature, culture, scale, and impact.

Investigations into the Springbrook Cableway concept are being progressed by the City of Gold Coast. As such, this is currently a matter for the City of Gold Coast.

No project has been formally submitted to the Queensland Government.
