MR L POWER ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to legislation requiring regular disclosure of RTI application details—
Will the Minister advise (a) why the QPS RTI Disclosure Log has not been updated since late 2024 and (b) will the Minister take responsibility for this?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Police Service (QPS) Right to Information Unit (RTI) is responsible for updating RTI details on the QPS website.

I am advised by the QPS that it receives a very high volume of applications, the largest in the State for a single agency. Most of these relate to complex or sensitive personal matters. Due to these factors, the upload of details to the Disclosure Log can be time consuming and at times delayed. This ensures the sensitive details of Queenslanders is protected.

I am further advised by the QPS that the RTI Unit is in the process of uploading application data to the Disclosure Log and publishing this information on the QPS website is a priority.
