MS W BOURNE ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (a) what steps the Minister and the Department of Transport and Main Roads will take to reduce the speed to 80 kms at the dangerous intersection of Haigslea-Amberley Road, Schultz Road and the Warrego Highway and (b) any other measures to ensure safety at this intersection?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

I refer the Member to petitions 4116-24 and 4157-24, where the former Minister for Transport and Main Roads and Minister for Digital Services advised in response that a speed limit review would be completed in late 2024.

Despite these assurances, I can confirm that a speed review was not conducted prior to the state election.

Nevertheless, the Crisafulli Government is committed to rectifying this issue inherited at the change of government, and completing the speed limit review, so that local residents' safety can be maintained.

Future safety upgrades will continue to be considered and evaluated in line with other safety project priorities and funding needs within the region.
