HON M DE BRENNI ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS
(HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

With reference to there having been widespread failures of street lighting on the M1 and associated on ramps and off ramps between Daisy Hill and the Logan Motorway—

Will the Minister advise when the street lighting will be fixed and operational?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The street lighting along the M1 between Daisy Hill and Logan Motorway has been significantly impacted by ongoing cable theft and vandalism. I acknowledge the widespread failure which has occurred over a number of years, including during the time of the former Labor Government, affecting traffic management assets across Southeast Queensland. In the Logan City Council area, there were 37 reported theft incidents in the 2024–25 financial year alone.

Repair works along the M1 are being prioritised with a focus on interchanges. Rectification works at Exit 35 have been completed and works to restore street lighting around Exit 31—which interfaces with the Logan Motorway—are scheduled to commence in 2026 subject to weather and conditions.
