MR B MELLISH ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (reported separately by financial year), (a) total funding allocated for the School Transport Infrastructure Program (STIP) in the 2025-26 Budget and across the Forward Estimates and (b) the funding allocated for the Flashing School Zone Signs (FSZS), Servicing and Maintenance Program in the 2025-26 Budget and across the Forward Estimates?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The budget for the School Transport Infrastructure Program is contained on page 104 of *Budget Paper No. 3 of the 2025–26 Budget*.

The budget for the Flashing School Zone Signs Program is part of the Targeted Road Safety Program contained in the *Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program 2025–26 to 2028–29* with a total of \$30.474 million allocated. This is made up of \$6.949 million in 2025–26 and \$23.525 million post 2025–26.

A detailed and accurate breakdown is not available, as the funding amounts for financial years across the Forward Estimates are subject to future budget considerations. Therefore, an aggregate post-2025–26 number is provided in line with publicly available information.
