HON G BUTCHER ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to victim data published on or around 13 November 2025—

Will the Minister advise how many of the offences for ‘Other Offences’ had a Domestic Violence flag applied (reported separately by month from December 2022 and by number and percentage of total ‘Other Offences’ offences)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the published victims data do not include ‘Other offences’, as offences in this category such as drug offences, good order offences, and traffic and related offences, do not have a victim.

As ‘other offences’ do not have a victim, the number of offences reported to police with a domestic violence flag is more suitable to be used.

I am advised by the QPS the number of ‘Other offences’ that had a domestic violence flag applied and the percentage of total ‘Other offences’ by month from December 2022 to November 2025 is detailed in the following table:
