MR S KING ASKED THE MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND WOMEN'S ECONOMIC SECURITY, MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS, AND MINISTER FOR MULTICULTURALISM (HON F SIMPSON)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Women's Career Grants—

Will the Minister advise (a) total number of applications received (reported separately by Local Government Area and Electorate (or nearest available regional breakdown/s)) and (b) total number of applications not approved due to funds being exhausted?

ANSWER:

Women's Career Grants is a Queensland Government initiative delivering on a key election commitment to offer practical assistance in breaking down barriers for unemployed women seeking to return to work after a career break of at least six months.

In response to your question, I can advise:

- a) The breakdown of application data as requested is not currently available.
- b) The current allocation to this initiative is \$20 million over four years, which will be distributed to successful applicants over multiple rounds. The total funding has not been exhausted.
