**MR L POWER** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the victims data published on the Queensland Police Service (QPS) website on 16 October 2025—

Will the Minister provide the number of victims (by rate) per 100,000 population (as per the population source at the month of occurrence) for Unlawful Entry, (reported separately by month) for December 2022 to September 2024 (inclusive)?

**ANSWER:**

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service that the rate of victims per 100,000 persons for unlawful entry from December 2022 to September 2024 is detailed in the following table:

**Rate of reported victims for Unlawful Entry by month, Queensland, 1 December 2022 to 30 September 2024**

**Notes:**

1. This data is preliminary and may be subject to change.
2. QPS do not attribute a personal victim to property offences, only a location. The victim is the location of the offence. It does not matter if the address is private or commercial or the number of occupants – the address is only counted as one victim. For example, if a car is stolen, the victim is the location from where it was stolen.
3. The data includes the following property offences: Unlawful Entry.
4. Figures do not represent a unique location count as a location may be the victim of more than one offence in the period.
5. Rates are expressed per 100,000 persons and are calculated based on the estimated residential population as at 30 June of each year.
