HON M DE BRENNI ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS
(**HON B MICKELBERG**)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise whether the government would contemplate a financial contribution via a 50:50 funding deal (or other amount), jointly with Brisbane and Logan City Councils on an upgrade to Rochedale Road between Underwood and Priestdale Roads (or further), as outlined in his letter to me dated 26 August 2025?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

I acknowledge that this road upgrade was not undertaken under the former Government. This road may be eligible for funding through the Transport Infrastructure Development Scheme (TIDS) under the Roads and Transport Alliance. Logan City Council falls under the remit of the Southern Regional Roads and Transport Group (SRRTG) which determines investment priorities for the annual TIDS allocation. Should the SRRTG deem future upgrades on Rochedale Road to be a high priority, based on 50:50 state and local government funding arrangements, the opportunity for part of the cost of these works can be offset within the annual SRRTG allocation.

My letter to the Member, dated 26 August 2025, was about the reliability of bus services in the Springwood electorate, and did not reference the issue to which this question refers to.
